Russian State Hydrometeorological University (RSHU) Saint-Petersburg (Russia), being a component of Regional Training Center of World Meteorological Organization (WMO) in Russia, approach to you on the issue Candidates from your country who would like to study in Russia by governmental quota in the 2022/2023 academic year and also who would like to apply for a WMO fellowship.

An admission of foreign students into Russian universities is accomplished by the governmental quotas which mean that education is paid by the Ministry of Education and Science of Russian Federation (RF).

*Master (2 years): *05.04.06 «Ecology and nature management», 05.04.05 «Applied Hydrometeorology»,

*PhD studies (3 years):*05.06.01 "Earth Science": 25.00.27 - Hydrology of land, water resources, hydrochemistry, 25.00.28 - Oceanology, 25.00.30 - Meteorology, climatology, agrometeorology, 25.00.35 - Geoinformatics and 25.00.36 – Geoecology

*Therefore, if NMS plans to point the candidates to study in Russia by the governmental quota (including applicants for the WMO scholarship), we kindly ask you to send us the number and information about of potential enrollees. *

DESCRIPTION OF CONDITIONS FOR STUDENTS

The Quota Scholarship Program offers fellowships to approve foreign students to study at RSHU. The scholarship includes:

1. Waiving of tuition fees for study at Bachelor, Master and PhD level;
2. Monthly stipend of 2400 RUR for undergraduate and graduate students and 7500 RUR for PhD students);
3. Accommodation (2 students in one room) at the University dormitory at the lowest price (about 1200 rubles per a month);
4. Free use of library and sport facilities at RSHU;
5. Meal at the University canteen at low price (100-150 RUR per one student for three course lunch);
6. Discount for a public transport use (1300 RUR per a month for use of all types of a city public transport);
7. Perfect discounts for visiting Museums, Theaters;
8. The lowest price for medical insurance.
